i. History of the institution

The Department began to function with the first batch of B.Ed Students admitted for the session 2005-2006. This was the major achievement for the society/MIT. Hundred % results were recorded in the first and second batch (2006-07) of B.Ed students with 98 and 100 intakes in each session.

The Department of Education attained a landmark when in it took a leap in getting permission from the NCTE, Govt. of Uttarakhand and the H.N.B.Garhwal University, Srinagar, Garhwal to open the Master of Education(M.Ed) course during the session 2007-08 with 25 intakes. The University results for M.Ed were recorded hundred percent (24 in the first division and 01 only in the second division).

Admissions in each course are made on the selection basis through conducting written test by the university. The peaceful environment of the department/ institute provides homogenous atmosphere for teaching and learning. The institute has a campus of 25 bighas. The Department of Education is well equipped with required lecture rooms, physical facilities and required infrastructures. It has well established central library consisting a good number of course books, reference books and the journals.
